- Improve communication, by enhancing participants' ability to craft clear, compelling narratives that resonate with audiences, both inside and outside of their department, organisation or business.
- Develop leadership and teambuilding, by strengthening collaboration, empathy, and understanding through shared writing and reflection, encouraging authentic written voices that create excitement.



- Our persuasive creative writing workshop will reignite your ability to write.


Words @ Work's approach is firmly practical: We lead workshops which involve actual writing and honest feedback.

### WRITERS IN RESIDENCE - YOUR COURSE TUTORS



**CHRISTOPHER WAKLING** is the author of seven acclaimed novels, including What I Did, The Devil's Mask, and Escape and Evasion. He has published travel writing, short stories, and adventures for children, too.

A former city lawyer, Christopher has held Royal Literary Fund Fellowships at the Universities of Bristol and Exeter, and has tutored numerous creative-writing courses for The Arvon Foundation and Curtis Brown Creative.



MONA ARSHI is a British poet, novelist, and former human rights lawyer. Mona practiced civil liberties law for a decade, working on landmark cases, including Diane Pretty's right-to-die case. She turned to poetry in 2008, completing an MA at the University of East Anglia. Her debut collection Small Hands (2015) won the Forward Prize for Best First Collection, followed by Dear Big Gods (2019) and Mouth (2025). Her first novel, Somebody Loves You (2021), was shortlisted for the Goldsmiths and Jhalak Prizes. Arshi's work explores themes of identity, loss, and belonging through innovative poetic forms. She is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Literature and Honorary Professor at the University of Liverpool. Her poetry has appeared in The Guardian, Granta, and on BBC Radio 4. Arshi continues to shape UK literature with her powerful, lyrical voice bridging law and art.

### **GUEST SPEAKER: ANTHONY TASGAL**

As global keynote speaker and TEDx presenter (Newcastle), Anthony blends storytelling, behavioural science, and strategic insight to help organisations communicate with clarity and impact. He is a Course Director for several leading professional bodies, including the Chartered Institute of Marketing, the Market Research Society, the Institute of Internal Communications, the Civil Service College, and the Chartered Institute of Procurement and Supply. Anthony writes a regular column for Director magazine (Institute of Directors), lectures at Buckinghamshire New University and Nottingham Trent University, and serves as a Brand Ambassador for the Home Grown Club in London. His clients include the BBC, Panasonic, Nokia, EE, the Royal Albert Hall, and the UK NHS. He is also the author of seven books, including the award-winning The Storytelling Book and The Classical Marketing Book, due for release in September 2025.





The workshop will be hosted in the magnificent seventeenth-century Hensol Castle, situated just outside Cardiff. **Words @ Work** will have exclusive use of the castle (excluding Hensol Castle Distillery and Atrium) for the course. The castle boasts a myriad of rooms to work in and comes complete with gin distillery, botanical gin-making school and beautiful grounds to explore.

Included in your stay is access to The Vale Resort Health Club\* and a round of golf\* on one of our championship courses. These are both just a 10 minute walk from the castle. If you want a more relaxed experience, you can book a spa treatment\*. These activities can be enjoyed at the completion of the course on the second day.







The castle is conveniently located, just 5 minutes from J34 of the M4, with plenty of on-site parking.

Nearest rail station is just 10 minutes by taxi. Use postcode CF72 8JX

### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### Can anyone come on this course?

Yes. It is designed for anyone who is in business, anyone who wants to be in business or just wants to unlock their creative writing skills to enhance their communication.

### What age group is the course designed for?

The course is open to anyone aged over 18.

### Can companies block book?

Yes. However, any block bookings must be paid in full at time of booking.

### What is the deposit?

We require a 50% deposit of the booking to ensure your place on the course. The remaining balance must be paid two weeks before the course commences. All deposits are non-refundable.

### Can I park at Hensol Castle?

Yes. There is ample free parking on site.

### What is included in my course fee?

All accommodation, course tuition, food and soft drinks are included. A complimentary round of golf at the Vale Resort is also included, plus access to the Health and Racquets Club. Any alcoholic drinks must be paid for when ordering. All spa treatments and access to spa relax zones are charged at full rate.

### Is there any shuttle service from the train stations?

No. However there are taxis at Cardiff station should you need them. If you are arriving at Pontyclun station you will need to call a local taxi firm as there is no taxi rank. All transfers are at your own expense.

### **HOW TO FIND US**

For Satnavs use Postcode CF72 8JX or search for Hensol Castle

### FROM LONDON

Take the M4 westbound, exit at junction 34 in South Wales.

### FROM MIDLANDS & THE NORTH

Take the M5, then the M50/A449 to Newport and then M4 to junction 34.

### FROM THE SOUTH WEST

Take the M5 north and exit onto the M49 or the M5/M4 interchange. Follow the M4 west into Wales and exit at junction 34.

### FROM WEST WALES

Take the M4 east and exit at J34.

### FROM JUNCTION 34

Take the exit signposted for Pendoylan and Hensol.

Take 1st right, following signs for Pendoylan, Hensol and Vale Resort

Continue down the road, then take 1st right, signposted Hensol, Miskin and Vale Resort.

Carry on around the bend, past all the houses on your left. Take a left turn and approach the gates, which will automatically open. Head straight on to Hensol Castle. The car park is on the right.
